This net is operated on 147.435 simplex with the major purpose of preparing Evanston hams to support the City of Evanston in emergency situations, as may be requested by the Evanston Office of Emergency Preparedness.

This is a directed net, which means that all transmissions should be addressed to the net control station, either by using the club callsign, KC9OAS, or by saying “net control.” The net control station may ask for assistance in the form of relays from stations not heard clearly by net control. If you are relaying information, please say your callsign and the word “relay” and wait for acknowledgment by net control.

Agenda for the net is checkins, (a brief training segment), announcements, and a roundtable discussion to give everyone a chance to participate in whatever manner they deem appropriate.
